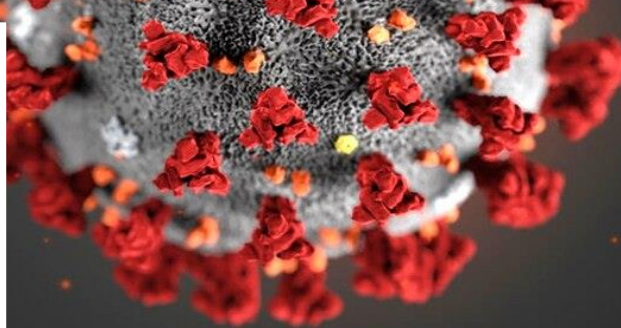

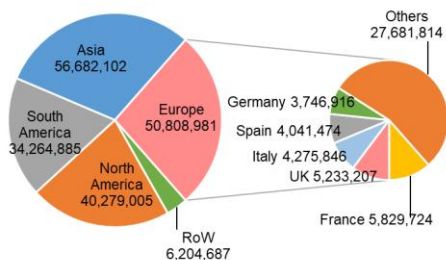

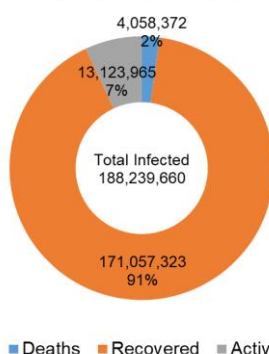
### Last Contagion Figures

- **July 14: 469,659 7-day average new cases**, compared to 409,406 a week ago and 377,515 a month ago. Now confirmed **188,239,660 cases worldwide** vs 184,952,044 cases last week.
- 4,058,372 people have died (2.2% of confirmed cases) and 171,057,323 have recovered (90.9%).
- **Europe:** 50,808,981 cases; 7-day avg growth of 91,786 vs 61,443 a week ago and 36,867 a month ago.
- **USA:** 33,947,230 cases; 7-day avg growth of 25,255 vs 15,068 a week ago and 13,805 a month ago.
- **Vaccines:** around 3.54 billion doses have been administered globally, of which 335 million in the **USA** and 416 million in the **EU**. 109 vaccines are in clinical evaluation and 184 vaccines are in preclinical evaluation.

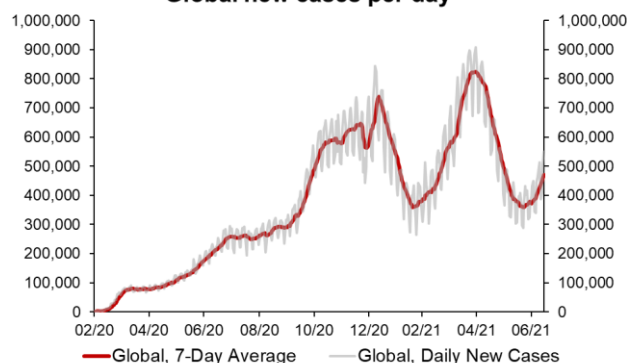
Global Confirmed Cases



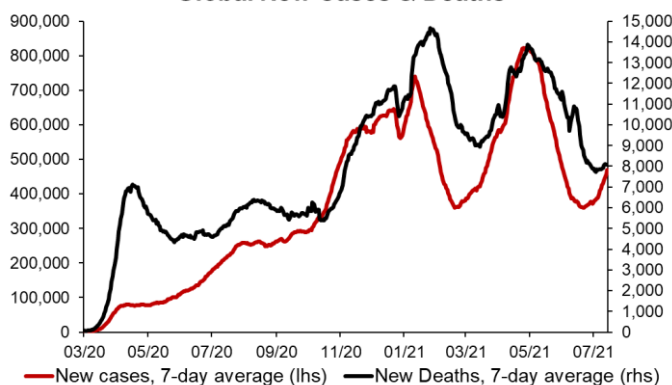
Global Infected Status



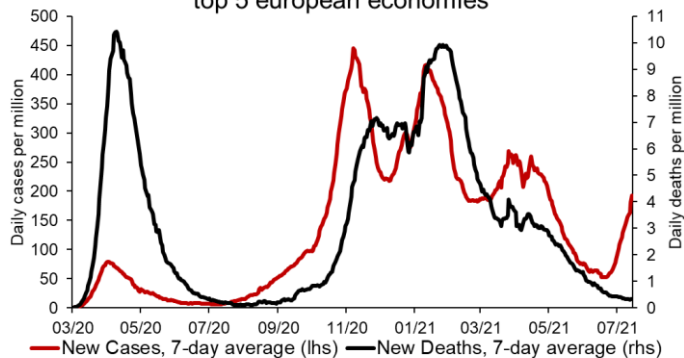
Global new cases per day



Global New Cases & Deaths



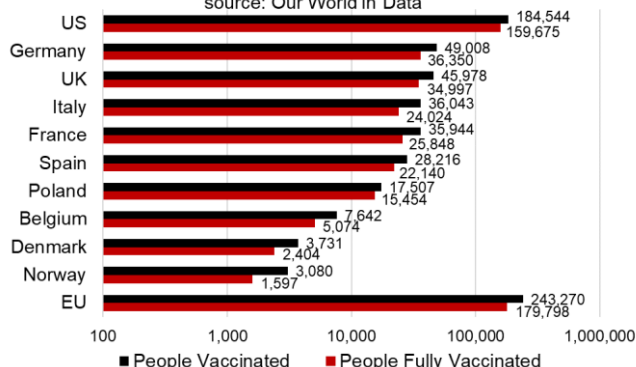
daily cases & deaths per million, 7-day avg

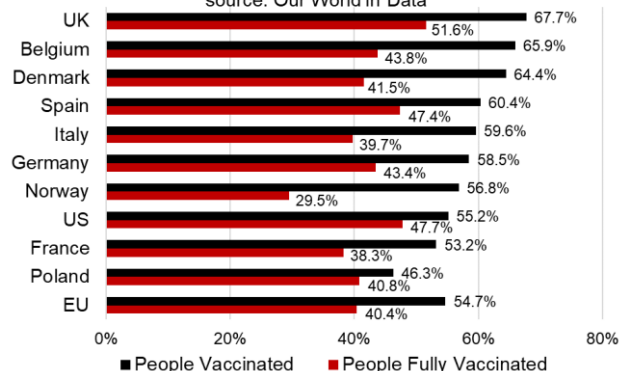

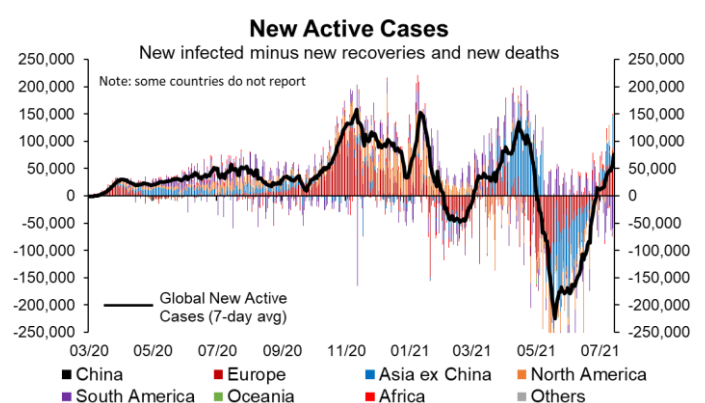
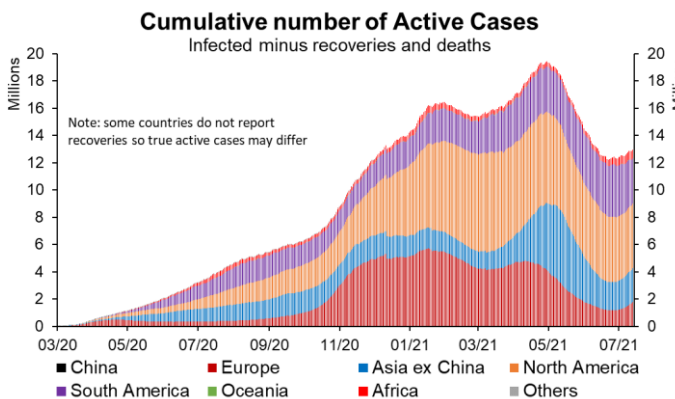
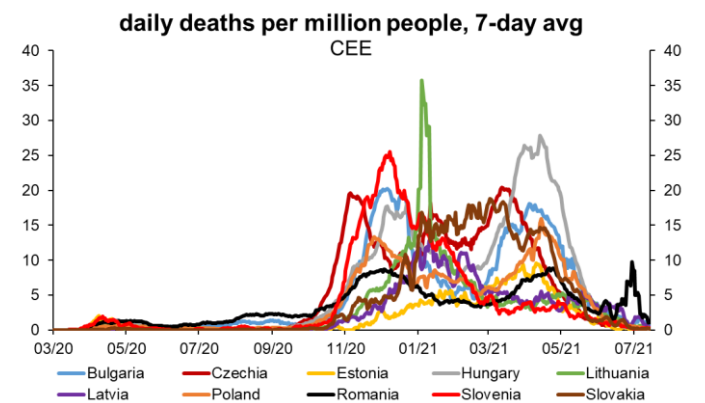
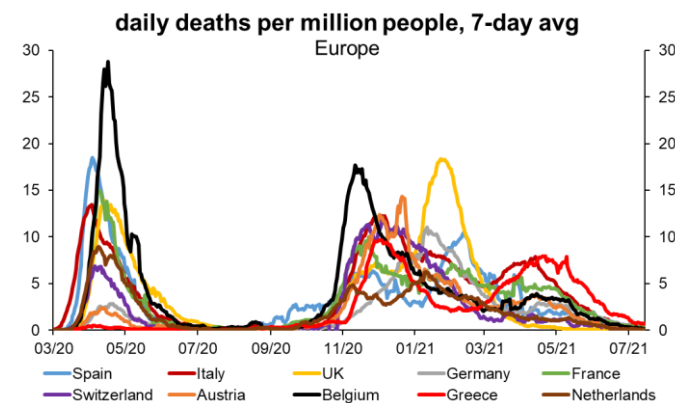
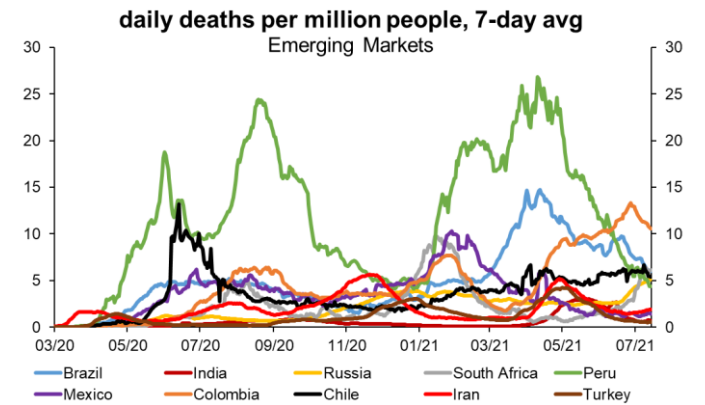
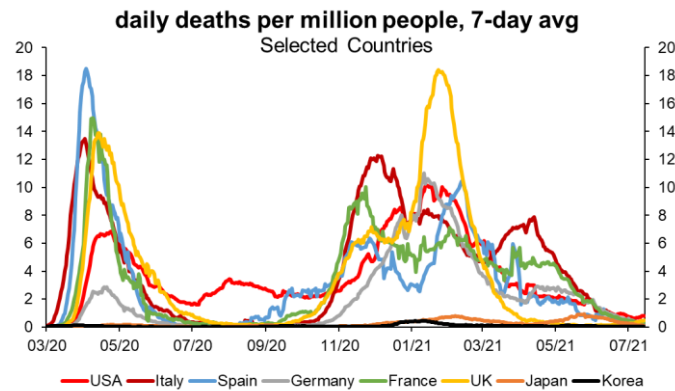
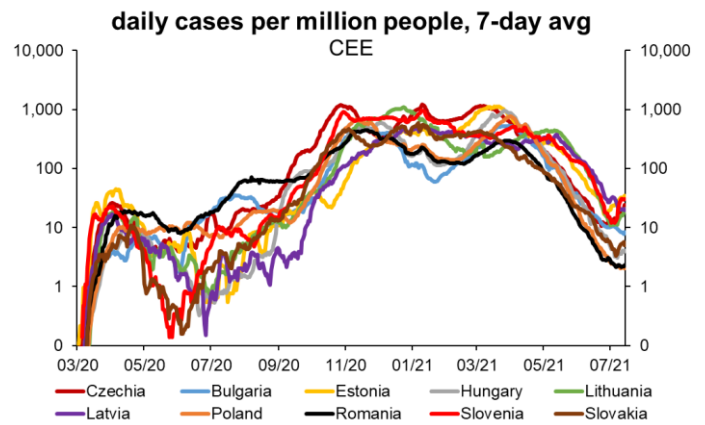
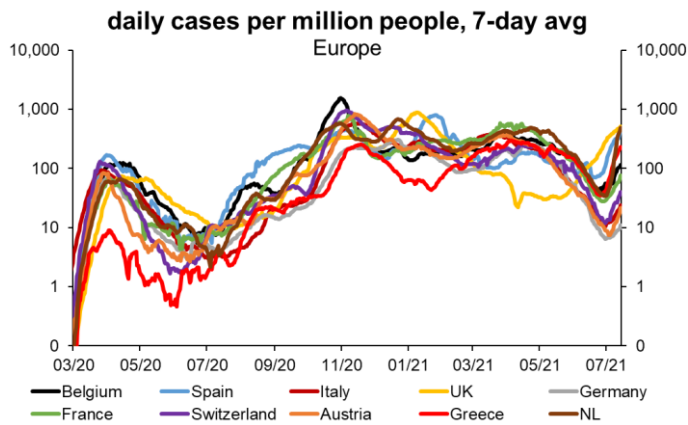


Percentage of people vaccinated

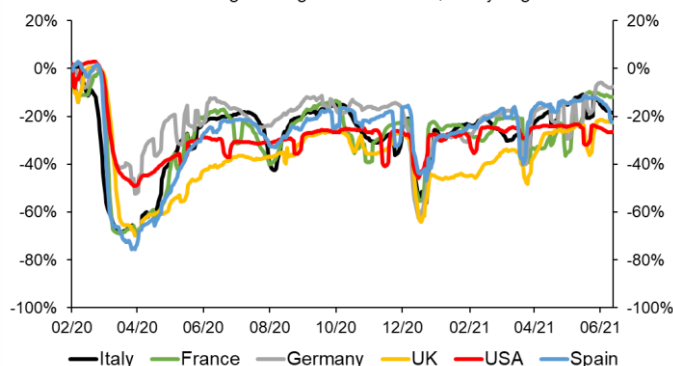

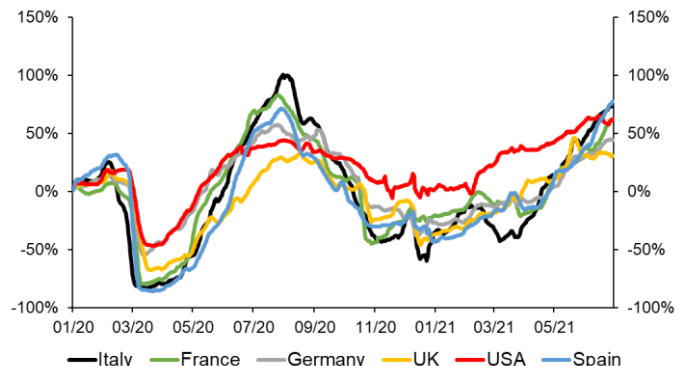
### Google Mobility Index: Workplaces

Percentage change from baseline, 7-day avg



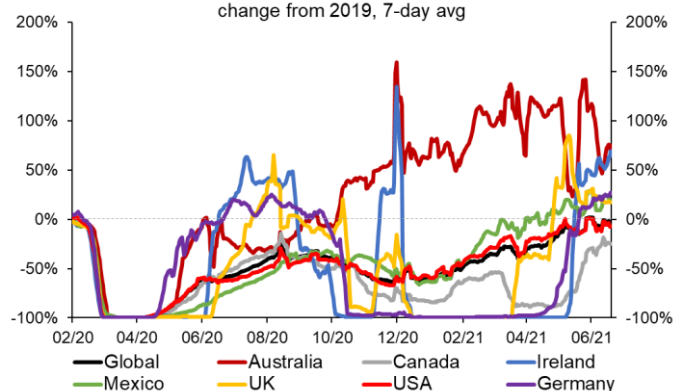
### Apple Mobility Index

## Main news

- Police in Paris fired tear gas and made arrests trying to disperse an anti-vax protest. The protest follows the decision to oblige health workers to get vaccinated and for people to show a vaccine health pass to enter most public places.
- European Commission chief said the European Union has delivered enough vaccine doses to member states to fully vaccinate at least 70% of adults.
- South Korea has announced tighter coronavirus restrictions in regions outside the capital as daily infections hit a new record due to the diffusion of the Delta variant.
- Australia has extended a lockdown in Sydney by at least 14 more days, as the outbreak of COVID-19 keeps growing even after three weeks of restrictions.
- The FDA added a warning to Johnson & Johnson's COVID-19 vaccine about links to a rare and potentially dangerous neurological reaction.
- Russia reported 752 coronavirus deaths on Saturday, a national record of pandemic-related fatalities over a 24-hour period.
- Japan has announced a new state of emergency in Tokyo. Spectators will not be allowed at the Olympics, which are due to start on July 23.
